DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

The Gycorine® solution should be prepared in a well ventilated area.

Directions for General Use

For sanitizing food processing equipment and utensils, rinse, wash and rinse all articles thoroughly, then apply a solution of Gycorine®. The food contact surfaces treated with Gycorine® must not be rinsed with potable water following treatment. Fresh Gycorine® solution should be prepared daily or more often if the solution becomes diluted or soiled.

Mix 9 oz. with 4 gallons of hot water (16,450 ppm). Apply the Gycorine® solution with a cloth, paper towel, brush, sponge, mechanical spray device or immerse the surface in the Gycorine® solution. Surfaces should be thoroughly wetted and remain wet for at least one (1) minute. The Gycorine® should be drained and allowed to air dry.

Storage and Disposal
