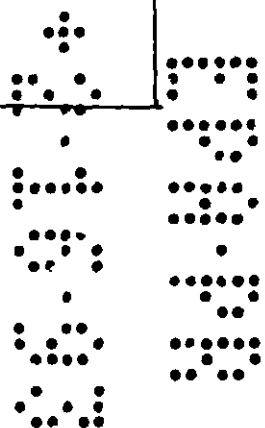

APPLICATION DIRECTIONS: Bug house bait is packaged in a plastic dispenser containing 2 oz. of bait. To control cockroaches. Bait can be applied as spots or as a bead in cracks and crevices. Recommended spot size $\frac{1}{4}$ - $\frac{1}{2}$ gram, or a 3 to 12 inch bead. Place under kitchen cabinets, behind refrigerator stove, sink, dishwasher, washing machine, and dryer, in openings around drains, water pipes, and electrical conduits, in corners, cracks and crevices of cabinets and closets, and other problem areas not accessible by children and pets. Reapply as necessary.
