    - c. Revise the footnote for permethrin as listed in the ingredient statement to read: \*Cis-trans isomers ratio: Min.65%( $\pm$ ) cis and Max. 35%( $\pm$ ) trans.

- d. Note that the address on the label is different from that on the Registration Application form. Please explain.
- 3. With respect to the submitted product chemistry data, the following comments apply:
  - a. The source product contains 2.016% rather than 2.00% permethrin and 0.175% rather than 0.016% Related Compounds.
  - b. Series 62-3 (Enforcement Analytical Method): you must cite another MRID number for the analytical method for determining permethrin in the product since MRID Number/Accession Number 00142794 for EPA Registration Number 1021-1402 refers to the determination of phenothrin.
  - c. Series 63-17 (Storage Stability): Storage stability tests for at least one year under ambient warehouse conditions must be conducted on the commercially packaged product. Citing other MGK Company data is not acceptable.
  - d. Series 63-20 (Corrosion Characteristics): This test must be conducted on the product in conjunction with the one year storage stability tests.
- 4. Submit three copies of the revised final printed label for the record.

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA sec. 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product constitutes acceptance of these conditions.
