2. Make the following label changes:

- a. Revise the EPA Registration Number to read, "EPA Reg. No. 66963-2."
- b. Add the word "kill" before ticks in the third sentence on back panel of label under the heading "Directions For Use."
- c. Revise the footnote for permethrin as listed in the ingredient statement to read: "Cis-trans isomers ratio: Min. 65%(+) cis and Max. 35%(+) trans."

d. Note that the address on the label is different from that on the Registration Application form. Please explain.

3. With respect to the submitted product chemistry data, the following comments apply:

- a. The source product contains 2.016% rather than 2.00% permethrin and 0.175% rather than 0.016% Related Compounds.
- b. Series 62-3 (Enforcement Analytical Method): you must cite another MRID number for the analytical method for determining permethrin in the product since MRID Number/Accession Number 00142794 for EPA Registration Number 1021-1402 refers to the determination of phenothrin.
- c. Series 63-17 (Storage Stability): Storage stability tests for at least one year under ambient warehouse conditions must be conducted on the commercially packaged product. Citing other MGK Company data is not acceptable.
- d. Series 63-20 (Corrosion Characteristics): This test must be conducted on the product in conjunction with the one year storage stability tests.

4. Submit three copies of the revised final printed label for the record.

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA sec. 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product constitutes acceptance of these conditions.

### DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

**HOLD CONTAINER UPRIGHT. SHAKE WELL BEFORE USING**

This product will kill fleas up to 14 days on dogs and cats and will ticks for four days on dogs and nine days on cats.

Spray animal from a distance of 8-12 inches. Start spraying at the tail, moving the dispenser rapidly and making sure the animal's entire body is covered, including the legs and under the body. Using a protective mitt or glove, fluff the hair as you spray so the spray will penetrate to the skin. The spray should wet the ticks thoroughly. Do not, however, over saturate the fur or skin of the animal. Do not spray in face, eyes or on genitalia. Repeat as needed.

For cats, apply at the rate of 1 second per pound of body weight. For dogs apply at the rate of 2 seconds per pound of body weight for thin or short-haired dogs and up to 8 seconds per pound of body weight for heavy or long-haired dogs.

### STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

**Storage:** Store in a cool, dry place away from heat or open flame. **Disposal:** Do not reuse empty container; wrap and put in trash collection.

### PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

#### Hazards to Humans & Domestic Animals

**CAUTION:** Harmful if swallowed. Avoid breathing vapors or spray mist. Avoid contact with skin or eyes. Avoid contamination of food or feedstuffs. Do not use on nursing puppies or kittens or animals under three months of age. Do not use on sick, old or debilitated animals.

#### Statement of Practical Treatment

**If Swallowed:** Call a physician or poison control center immediately. **If In Eyes:** Flush with plenty of water.
