- a. Revise the EPA Registration Number to read, "EPA Reg. No. 66963-3".
- b. Revise the "Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals" section so that it reads:

"Harmful if inhaled or absorbed through the skin. Avoid breathing spray mist or vapor. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling. Remove pets, birds and cover fish aquaria before space spraying or surface applications."

- c. Revise the "Statement of Practical Treatment" so that it reads:

"If on skin: Wash with plenty of soap and water. Get medical attention if irritation persists. If inhaled: Remove victim to fresh air. If not breathing, give artificial respiration, preferably mouth-to-mouth. Get medical attention." (Note, your proposed labeling also has statement of practical treatment language with instructions in case the product is in the eyes or swallowed. These may be retained. However, the Agency does not require that they appear on this label at this time.)

3. Submit two copies of the revised final printed label for the record.

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA sec. 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product constitutes acceptance of these conditions.

A stamped copy of the label is enclosed for your records.

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

### STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

**Storage:** Store in original container in a cool, dry place inaccessible to children and pets. Protect from freezing. **Disposal:** Do not reuse empty container; wrap and put in trash collection.

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To kill crawling insects (*Ants, Boxelder Bugs, Centipedes, Clover Mites, Cockroaches, Crickets, Earwigs, Grain Mites, Silverfish, Sowbugs and Spiders*), turn sprayer nozzle to stream position and spray directly into cracks, crevices and other hiding places along baseboards, hitting as many bugs as possible. Repeat as necessary. Keep about three feet away from walls, fabrics and furniture.

To kill flying insects (*Flies, Gnats, Houseflies, Mediterranean Flour Moths, Mosquitoes and Small Flying Moths*), turn sprayer nozzle to spray position. Keep about three feet away from walls, fabrics and furniture.

To kill *Hornets and Wasps*, turn sprayer nozzle to stream position. Spray directly on insects whenever possible. Apply a wet spray after dark when all insects have returned to their nests.

To kill garden insects on house plants and ornamental plants outdoors, turn sprayer nozzle to spray position. Direct spray so that upper and lower leaf surfaces are contacted. To control *Aphids, Bagworms, Flea Beetles, Japanese Beetles, Lace Bugs, Leaf Hoppers, Leaf-tiers, Mimosa Webworm Larvae, Plant Bugs, Thrips and Whiteflies*, use fine mist spray about 18 to 24 inches from infested plants. Use caution on new growth and tender foliage. Repeat treatment as necessary. Avoid spraying plants when temperature exceeds 85°F. Spray when air is still. Avoid heavy wetting.

To kill *Fleas and Ticks* on dogs and cats, turn sprayer nozzle to spray position. Start spraying at the animal's head, avoiding the eyes, nose and mouth as you spray. Make sure the animal's entire body is covered including the legs, underbody and tail. While spraying, fluff the hair so that the spray will penetrate the skin. Make sure spray wets thoroughly. Avoid contact with genitalia. Repeat as necessary.

To control *Fleas and Brown Dog Ticks* in pet areas on premises, turn sprayer nozzle to spray position. Thoroughly spray infested areas, pet beds, resting quarters, nearby cracks and crevices, along and behind baseboards, moldings, window and door frames, and entire areas of floor and floor covering. Fresh bedding should be placed in animal quarters following treatment. Concurrent treatment of animals is recommended. Repeat treatment as needed.

### PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS Hazards to Humans & Domestic Animals

**CAUTION:** Harmful if swallowed. Avoid contamination of feed and foodstuffs. Remove pets, birds and cover fish aquaria before space spraying or surface applications.

#### Statement of Practical Treatment

**If Swallowed:** Drink one or two glasses of water and induce vomiting by touching the back of the throat with finger. Repeat until vomit fluid is clear. Call a physician immediately. Do not induce vomiting or give anything by mouth to an unconscious or convulsing person.

**If Inhaled:** Remove person to fresh air. Apply artificial respiration if indicated. Contact a physician if warranted. **If on Skin:** Remove contaminated clothing and wash affected areas with soap and water. Contact a physician if irritation persists. Launder clothing, separately from other clothing, prior to reuse. **If in Eyes:** Flush eyes with plenty of water. Call a physician if irritation persists.
