DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.
For Control of Ticks, Fleas and Lice on Dogs and Cats: dilute 4 ounces of concentrate with 1 gallon of water. Dip animal into solution, making sure hair is thoroughly wet to the skin. For control of ear mites, while dripping, lightly sponge inside of ears. Do not rinse. Towel dry. Repeat as necessary.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Storage: Store in original container a cool, dry place inaccessible to children and pets. Protect from freezing. **Disposal:** Do not reuse empty container; wrap and put in trash collection.

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS Hazards to Humans & Domestic Animals

CAUTION: Harmful if swallowed. Avoid contact with eyes. Do not contaminate food or feedstuffs with this concentrate or dip. **Animals:** Do not treat kittens or puppies less than four weeks of age. Avoid contact of material with eyes or mouth of animal.

Statement of Practical Treatment
