DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Storage: Store in original container in a cool, dry place inaccessible to children and pets. Protect from freezing. Disposal: Do not reuse empty container; wrap and put in trash collection.

This product has been especially developed for use on horses. It provides a protective hair coating against flies while imparting a high sheen to the hair when brushed out. One to two ounces per head per day give adequate protection. Apply by either soft cloth or fine mist spray.

For Use as a Wipe On: First, brush animal to remove excess dirt and dust. Moisten, but do not wet to the point of dripping, a soft cloth and rub over the hair. It is best to apply by rubbing against the hair growth. Give special attention to the legs, shoulders, shanks, neck and facial areas where flies are most often seen. Only a light application is required. Avoid using an excessive amount on your horses. Do not wet the skin. After application, brush thoroughly to bring out bright sheen on the coat. Repeat daily or as required.

For Use as a Spray: This product may be applied as a fine mist spray to stable area and over and around stabled horses for fast paralysis and kill of flies. Do not wet horse's skin or exceed two ounces per application.

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

Hazards to Humans & Domestic Animals

CAUTION: Harmful if swallowed. Remove or cover exposed foods before spraying. Do not apply to dairy animals.

Statement of Practical Treatment
