#### **DIRECTIONS FOR USE**

For best results apply to a clean horse. Prior to application, brush coat to remove excess dirt and dust. Dilution Directions: To be used in a clean spray container of your choice. Dilute with 5 parts water to 1 part horse spray. When pest pressure is high, dilute 4 parts water to 1 part

<u>Application [Directions] [Instructions]:</u> **SHAKE CONTAINER BEFORE EACH APPLICATION. -or- [SHAKE WELL BEFORE USE.]** Hold spray container 10 to 12 inches from coat for best application. Do

not spray solution directly onto horse's facial area. Instead, spray solution onto clean cloth and use cloth to apply Aloe Herbal Horse Spray to horse's facial area. Reapply every 3 hours or as needed.

Do not use on animals intended for human consumption.

### STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal.

**PESTICIDE STORAGE:** Store only in a cool, dry area inaccessible to children and pets. Keep container tightly closed when not in use.

Shake for 10 seconds. Pour rinsate into application equipment or a mix tank or store rinsate for later use or disposal. Drain for 10 seconds after the flow begins to drip. Repeat this procedure two more times. Then offer for recycling if available or place in trash or in a sanitary landfill.
