APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS

SHAKE CONTAINER BEFORE EACH APPLICATION.

Hold spray container 10 to 12 inches from horse's coat for best application. Do not spray solution directly onto horse's facial area. Instead, spray solution onto clean cloth and use the cloth to apply Aloe Herbal Horse Spray Ready-To-Use to horse's facial area. Reapply every 3 hours or as needed.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal.

PESTICIDE STORAGE

Store only in a cool, dry area inaccessible to children and pets. Keep container tightly closed when not in use.

PESTICIDE DISPOSAL
