In addition, regardless of whether a website is referenced on your product’s label, claims made on the website may not substantially differ from those claims approved through the registration process. Therefore, should the EPA find or if it is brought to our attention that a website contains false or misleading statements or claims substantially differing from the EPA-approved registration, the website will be referred to the EPA’s Office of Enforcement and Compliance Assurance.

APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS

SHAKE CONTAINER BEFORE EACH APPLICATION -or- [SHAKE WELL BEFORE USE].

Hold spray container 10 to 12 inches from horse's coat for best application. Do not spray solution directly onto horse's facial area. Instead, spray solution onto clean cloth and use the cloth to apply Aloe Herbal Horse Spray Ready-To-Use to horse's facial area. Reapply every 3 hours or as needed.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal.

PESTICIDE STORAGE

Store only in a cool, dry area inaccessible to children and pets. Keep container tightly closed when not in use.

PESTICIDE DISPOSAL
