If in Eyes: Flush eyes with plenty of water. Call a physician if irritation persists.

If on Skin: Wash with plenty of soap and water. Get medical attention.

This action is taken under the authority of section 4(g)(2)(C) of the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended. Reregistration under this section does not eliminate the need for control reassessment of pesticides. EPA may require submission of data at any time to maintain the registration of your product.

Homes, Restaurants, Food and Feed Handling Establishments, Markets, Schools, Warehouses, Factories, Offices, Hotels, Motels, Hospitals, Nursing Homes, Garages, Grocery Stores, Apartment Buildings, New Construction, Industrial Plants, Theaters, Ships, Boats, Trains, Trucks, Yachts, Camps, Mobile Homes, Buses, Zoos, Kennels, Military Bases, Libraries, Utilities, Sewers.

**DIRECTIONS**

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

To control cockroaches, ants, termites under and behind refrigerator, washing machine and dryer, water pipes and electrical conduits along baseboards and corners of closets. Remove all lower doors of cabinets, bedroom dresser drawers. Scatter liberally in drawer wells.

Reapply as necessary. Any residue must be brushed into cracks and crevices only in areas inaccessible to consumption of feed and foodstuffs.

**Directions for Applying in Food and Feed Handling Establishments.** When treating soffits and subcabinet voids, apply dust liberally using dusting application. **Directions for Applying in Non-Food Areas.** Add 1 cup of water. Apply to floor areas of application. Supplemental treatment.

**Food and Feed Handling Establishments.** In private residences in which food is prepared or served.

**FOOD AREA APPLICATIONS AND CREVICE**

Includes areas for receiving, bottling, wrapping, boxing, processing, enclosed processing systems (e.g., syrups). Serving areas (when in operation) also would be covered.

Apply in small amounts directly with a bulbous duster or other device, applying insecticide directly between different elements of walls, equipment legs and baseboards, electrical switch boxes where accessible.
