This is in response to your amendment of revised Confidential Statements of Formula for three suppliers, revised labels and product name change from "S. D. I. C. Granular" to "S. D. I. C. 62 Granular".

The labeling referred to above submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended is acceptable subject to the following comment.

1. After "Corrosive" delete "May be fatal if absorbed through skin". Revise "Harmful if swallowed" to read "Harmful if swallowed or absorbed through skin".

A stamped copy is enclosed for your records. Submit five copies of the final printed label.

The revised Confidential Statements of Formula dated July 19, 1994 with the addition of three suppliers for the technical source, Sodium dichloro-s-triazinetrione are acceptable.

We have amend, our records to reflect the product name change, as indicated above.
