APPLICATIONS

Use in natural or manmade ponds, lakes, fountains, fish farms, fish hatcheries, golf course and swimming ponds. Water must be under the complete control of the user and have little or no outflow (dye concentration must be maintained). Do not apply directly to streams, or any body of water that may be used for human consumption. Do not apply to water for swimming pools if chlorine is used, as color will degrade.

APPLICATION PROCEDURES

Admiral™ WSP is a concentrated blend of dry-flowable colorants in pre-measured water soluble packets (WSPs). Admiral™ WSP is formulated for ease of application. The pre-measured WSPs with the colorant. Rate calculations are also simplified.

Optimum results are achieved by applying prior to or early in the growing season when weeds are on the bottom of a body of water or when aquatic vegetation is growing at depths greater than 2 feet. Reapply as needed during the growing season.

Physical removal or other aquatic weed control methods may be used before or after applications of Admiral. When using an aquatic herbicide, follow all label restrictions, precautions, and directions for use.

Open carton and remove WSP multi-pack. Open twist-tie and remove the desired number of WSPs from the multi-pack. Seal WSP multi-pack with twist-tie and store in original carton.
