APPLICATION PROCEDURES

Admiral® WSP is a concentrated blend of dry flowable colorants in pre-measured water soluble packets (WSPs). Admiral® WSP is formulated for ease of application. Rate calculations are also simplified.

Optimum results are achieved by applying prior to or early in the growing season when weeds are on the bottom of a body of water or when aquatic vegetation is growing at depths greater than 2 feet. Reapply as needed during the growing season.

Physical removal or other aquatic weed control methods may be used before or after applications of Admiral. When using an aquatic herbicide, follow all label restrictions, precautions and directions for use.

Open carton and remove WSP multi pack. Open, twist tie and remove the desired number of WSPs from the multi pack. Seal WSP multi pack with twist tie and store in original carton.

Place Admiral® WSP directly into the water. Consult the recommended dosage chart for the suggested rates of WSPs. Use this product in open areas only.

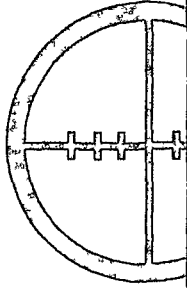
