As per PR Notice 98-10, these changes can be accomplished through the Notification process and as such there are no PRIA fees associated with this action.

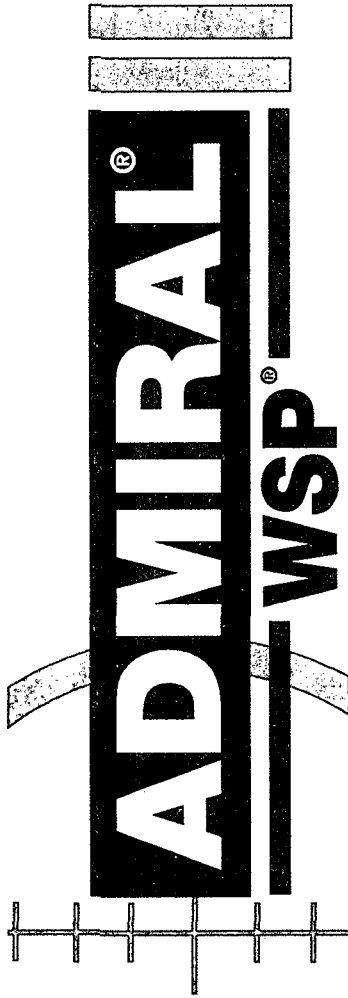

Use in natural or man-made ponds, lakes, fountains, fish farms, fish hatcheries, golf course and swimming ponds. Water must be under the complete control of the user and have little or no outflow (dye concentration must be "rain-rinced"). Admiral® WSP is a concentrated blend of dry-flowable colorants in pre-measured water soluble packets (WSPs). Admiral WSP is formulated for ease of application. Rate calculations are also simplified.

Optimum results are achieved by applying prior to or early in the growing season when weeds are on the bottom of a body of water or when aquatic vegetation is growing at depths greater than 2 feet. Reapply as needed during the growing season.

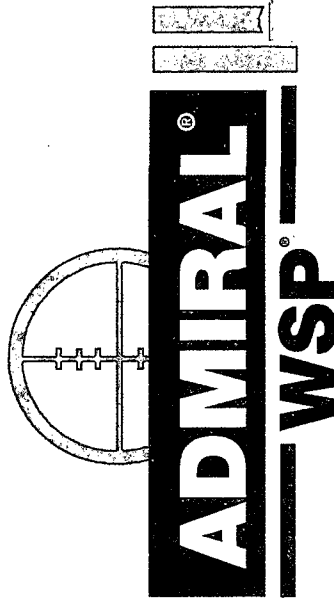

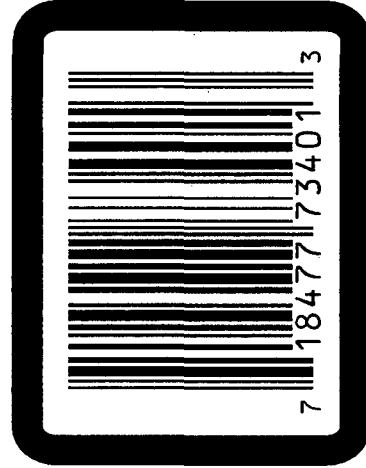
