INDUSTRIAL RECIRCULATING WATER COOLING TOWER registered under EPA Reg. No.

67071-8

Acticide LG-W microbiocide is recommended for the control of bacteria, algae and fungi. It should be added to the tower basin or some other point to ensure uniform mixing.

Add 0.3 to 1.86 lb of Acticide LG-W per 1000 gallons of water (35 to 220 ppm Acticide LG-W) weekly or as needed for maintenance. For noticeably fouled systems use an initial dose of 1.26 to 7.5 lb Acticide LG-W per 1000 gallons of water. Repeat if necessary to achieve control.

AIR WASHER SYSTEMS

For use only in industrial air washing systems that maintain effective mist eliminating components. Add 0.3 to 7.5 lb Acticide LG-W to 1000 gallons of water (35 to 886 ppm Acticide LG-W) in the air washer sump, or chill water sump to ensure uniform mixing, for the control of bacteria, fungi and algae. A repeat treatment may be needed depending on the severity of contamination.

BREWERY PASTEURIZERS AND CAN WARMER SYSTEMS

Add 0.3 to 1.86 lb of Acticide LG-W per 1000 gallons of water in the system weekly or as needed to maintain control of bacteria, algae and fungi. For noticeably fouled systems an initial treatment with 1.25 to 7.5 lb of Acticide LG-W per 1000 gallons of water may be needed depending on the severity of the fouling.
