

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Acticide DQ is added at a level of 0.4 to 1.5 lb (180 - 680 grams) to each 1000 lb (453.6 kilograms) of product to be protected to provide 6 to 22.5 ppm of active isothiazolinones.

For control of bacteria and fungi in liquid detergents, in liquid laundry products and also in dishwashing detergents, waxes, polishes and other similar cleaners, use 0.4 to 1.0 lb of Acticide DQ per each 1000 lb (453.6 kilograms) of treated product to provide a level of 6 to 15 ppm of active ingredient (isothiazolinones).

Acticide DQ may also be used for control of bacteria and fungi in package utility products such as pre-moistened sponges and mops. Use 0.4 to 1.5 lb in each 1000 lb of water to pre-moisten sponges and mops.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

STORAGE

This product (pH 3.5) is corrosive to mild steel. Do not store or transport in unlined metal containers. Do not contaminate food or feed by storage, disposal or cleaning of equipment.

PESTICIDE DISPOSAL

Pesticide wastes are acutely hazardous. Improper disposal of excess pesticide or rinsate is a violation of Federal law. If these wastes cannot be disposed of by use according to label instructions, contact your State Pesticide or Environmental Control Agency or the Hazardous Waste representative at the nearest EPA Regional Office for guidance.

CONTAINER DISPOSAL

Metal containers: Triple rinse (or equivalent). Then offer for recycling or reconditioning, or puncture and dispose of in a sanitary landfill or by other procedures approved by state and local authorities.

Plastic containers: Triple rinse (or equivalent). Then offer for recycling or reconditioning, or puncture and dispose of in a sanitary landfill or incinerator or, if allowed by state and local authorities, by burning. If burned, stay out of smoke.
