b. Submit two (2) copies of the revised final printed label for the record.

3. The Confidential Statement of Formula dated September 14, 1999 is in compliance with PR Notice 91-2, it agrees with the label and is acceptable. However, the following studies were missing from the product chemistry data package and must be submitted.

A. Provide missing dissociation constant (830.7370)

B. Provide test results from a one-year storage stability study (830.6317)

4. On the front panel change the descriptive language from "For Formulation of Industrial Microbiocides" to "For Formulation of In-Door Use Industrial Preservative Microbiocide. This is not a Manufacturing Use Product.

5. On the back panel change the second paragraph under the "Direction For Use" section to read: "Acticide BI? is a manufacturing use product for use in formulating pesticide preservative for use in treating oil in water emulsions, . . . hides and skins".

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA sec. 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product constitutes acceptance of these conditions.
