DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

LEATHER PRESERVATION: Acticide WB 200 is recommended for the prevention of bacterial and fungal growth on wet leather stock such as pickled, chrome-tanned and vegetable-tanned hides and leather, including wet-blues. Normal addition levels are in the range of 0.02% - 0.10% by weight of Acticide WB 200 calculated on the pelt weight. The optimum use concentrations will depend on the manufacturing process, the required properties of the product and the environment to which it will be exposed. Levels will be particularly affected by natural fat content, skin thickness, storage time and tannery conditions

Emulsion Preparation: The emulsion of Adicide WB 200 has only short term stability and therefore it should be prepared immediately before addition to the drum. For optimum stability the biocide must be added to the water rather than vice versa and should be diluted to give a concentration of at least 1:40. In order to obtain a homogeneous distribution on skins, the emulsion must be added slowly and immediately after the first application of chrome during the tanning process.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate food or feed by storage, disposal or cleaning of equipment.

STORAGE DISPOSAL: This product is corrosive to mild steel. Do not store or transport in unlined metal containers.

PESTICIDE DISPOSAL: Pesticide wastes are acutely hazardous. Improper disposal of excess pesticide or rinsate is a violation of Federal Law.
