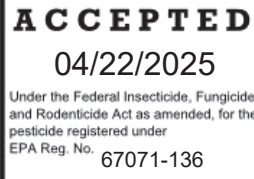

[*] Stucco and EIFS coatings	0.5-1.5%

[*] Paper Coatings via application into a size-press, water box, wet-stack (wet web) or drystack application at a dose rate of 0.05 to 2.0% based on the total weight of the treating solution.
