

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

SHAKE BEFORE USE. HOLD CONTAINER UPRIGHT. APPLY IN SHORT BURSTS.

FOR SPACE SPRAY: To Kill Flies, Gnats, Mosquitoes, Small Flying Moths and Wasps: Close all doors and windows and direct spray upward into center of room with a slow sweeping motion. Spray 5-10 seconds for average room. Keep room closed for 15 minutes after spraying. Ventilate room thoroughly before re-entry. Sweep up and destroy fallen insects. Before spraying cover exposed food and utensils.

FOR SPOT TREATMENT: To Kill Ants, Cockroaches and Crickets: Contact as many insects as possible with the spray in addition to thorough spraying of all parts of the room suspected of harboring these pests. Special attention should be paid to cracks, hidden surfaces under sinks, behind stoves and refrigerators, food storage areas and wherever these pests are suspected of hiding. To kill ants, treat doors, around window frames, ant trails and other areas of entry. Repeat as necessary.

To Kill Exposed Scorpions, Rice Weevils, and Spiders: Find and destroy insects on the shelves and remove them if they have dried. Repeat as necessary.
To Kill Centipedes, Flies and Spiders: Contact with the spray. Also the room suspected of harboring them. Attention should be paid to surfaces under sinks and refrigerators.

To Kill Brown Dog Ticks: destroy pet's old bedding of pets, around base of frames, wall cracks and as necessary. DO NOT wash bedding should be removed fresh bedding after treatment. cats with a registered veterinarian before allowing them to sleep on it.
FOR CRACK AND CRACKS: Dog Ticks, Carpet Beetles, Fleas, Silverfish. Apply spray in small cracks and crevices. Equipment should be used in elements of construction floors, openings leading in walls, equipment legs. listed insects hide. Avoid contamination of surfaces. Do not use this unit in or table. Do not use this cubic feet.

STORAGE: Store in a cool, dry place away from heat or open flame.
DISPOSAL: Replace container in trash. Do not incinerate.
