This product is conditionally registered in accordance with FIFRA sec. 3(c)(7)(A) provided that you:

1. Submit/cite all data required for registration/reregistration of your product under FIFRA section 3(c)(5) when the Agency requires all registrants of similar products to submit such data; and submit acceptable responses required for reregistration of your product under FIFRA section 4.

2. Make the labeling changes listed below before you release the product for shipment:

- a. Add the phrase, "EPA Registration No. 67197-2".
- b. Revise the Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals as follows:

Causes substantial but temporary eye injury. Do not get into eyes or on clothing. Avoid breathing dust. Wear goggles and a dusk mask. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling. Remove contaminated clothing and wash before reuse. Avoid contamination of food and foodstuffs. In the home foods must be removed or covered during treatment. All food handling surfaces should be covered or thoroughly cleaned before using. This product is toxic to fish. Cover or remove fish bowl and aquariums in treated area.

c. Revised the Environmental Hazards as follows:

This product is toxic to fish. Do not apply directly to any body of water. Do not contaminated water by disposing of equipment washwaters. Apply this product only as specified on the label.

d. Delete the words "and state" from the label violation statement under the Directions for Use heading.

e. Delete the reference to fire ants. We do not have data indicating control of fire ants in the manner you propose. In addition, we are concerned about the safety of the applicator with respect to the dry application method (applicator being a homeowner). Directions normally direct the user not to disturb the mound.

3. Submit five copies of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment. Refer to the A-79 Enclosure for a further description of final printed labeling.

4. The primary eye irritation study (MRID 426990-01) and dermal irritation study (MRID 426990-02) were acceptable and assigned Toxicity Category II and IV respectively. The remaining acute toxicity data submitted in support of the registration are currently in review. Please note that additional labeling changes may be required once our review has been completed.

5. The Confidential Statement of Formula (CSF) submitted will not meet the label claim for the nominal concentration for the active ingredients. The upper and lower certified limits are based on the pure active ingredient rather than the technical or concentrate. Refer the PR Notice 91-2 and 40 CFR 158.175 for guidance and revised the CSF to reflect the nominal concentration of the pure active ingredient.

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA sec. 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product constitutes acceptance of these conditions.
