**DIRECTIONS FOR USE:**

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

This product is labeled to be used in and around the home, yard, and animal housing. It can be applied as a dry dust or mixed with water at the rate of 2 ounces per quart and sprayed as a liquid. NOTE: 1 ounce of this product is 8 level teaspoons. The dust does not dissolve, and to help keep it in suspension, add one tablespoon of mild detergent per gallon of water, and agitate the sprayer now and then. With either method, the idea is to coat all areas where bugs may be.

**DRY USE INSTRUCTIONS:** HOUSEHOLD INSECTICIDE can be applied by the use of any equipment to handle dust or powder, whether it be hand or power operated.

**ROACHES & SILVERFISH:** In most cases general application is not needed, but localized attention to cracks & crevices, under stoves & refrigerators, and in likely hiding places. Be sure to treat around sinks and drain pipes, and if there is an opening into the sewer line, blow a considerable amount of product in the line. Being closed, air pressure forces the dust further down the line, coating the upper half of the pipe, leaving no safe place for roaches. This protection exists as far as the line is coated.

**CRICKETS, SCORPIONS & BOX ELDER BUGS:** Dust lightly areas around windows, doors and other places where pests may enter.

**ANTS:** Dry Powder: Stir the mound with a rake or other tool, agitating the ants. Apply Perma Guard Household Insecticide dust liberally on the immediate area, contacting as many ants as possible. Repeat if needed for final results. Wet Application: Use one-half cup of Perma Guard Household Insecticide with a teaspoon of a mild detergent per gallon of water. Saturate the mound or bed with the entire gallon of mixture. Repeat if necessary.

**FIRE ANTS:** Mix four tablespoonfuls to one-half cup of Perma Guard Household Insecticide with a teaspoon of a mild detergent in a gallon of water. Stir the fire ant mound with a rake or other tool to agitate the fire ants. Drench each individual fire ant mound with a gallon of the mixture. Repeat treatment if needed. Dry Powder: For faster knockdown! Stir the fire ant mound with a rake or other tool agitating the ants. Apply Perma Guard Household Insecticide liberally on the immediate area, contacting as many ants as possible. Repeat treatment as needed.

**FLEAS:** Apply liberally to all parts of animal close to skin. **RUGS:** Make a thin coating on rug. Rake (not sweep) nap back and forth, causing dust to enter rug. Leave overnight. When cleaning do not make special effort to remove dust in rug. It will kill live fleas, repel others, and will deodorize carpet.

**OUTSIDE AREA:** Apply 8 to 16 oz. of dust per 1000 sq. ft. of yard. Two or three applications per year should do the job. This can be done as dry dust or as wettable powder, using suitable equipment.

**FLIES:** Lightly coat window sills so flies lighting will contact the dust. If the outside walls of the house, shrubbery, outbuildings, such as barns, stables, kennels or corrals are dusted, flies are greatly reduced. Repeat if needed.
