**WET APPLICATION RATE:**  
When using PERMA GUARD INSECTICIDE AS A WET SPRAY, it is merely a means of using the insecticide. **MIXING INSTRUCTIONS:**  
**MINIMUM:** 1 lb to 2 gals  
**MAXIMUM:** 1 lb to 25 gals  
The purpose is to get a soaker spray, and still put the residue on the plant. Again, it is essential to get good coverage on top and bottom of leaves.
