**APPLICATOR:** A good dust applicator equipped with electronic nozzle is recommended. The plant being protected should be covered evenly on leaf bottom.

**WET APPLICATION RATE:** when using PERMA GUARD AS A WETTABLE POWDER using existing spray equipment. **MIXING INSTRUCTIONS:** **MINIMUM:** 1 lb to 2 gals of water. **MAXIMUM:** 1 lb to 25 gals of water. The purpose is to get a spray from the nozzle, and still put the residue on the plant. Again, it is essential to get coverage on top and bottom.
