Dear Mr. Currie:

The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable subject to the comments listed below. Two (2) copies of the finished labeling must be submitted prior to releasing the product for shipment. A stamped copy of the label is enclosed for your records.

- 1. Under Precautionary statements, add "Wear goggles or safety glasses. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling and before eating, drinking, chewing gum, or using tobacco" after the sentence beginning with "Avoid contact with eyes,..."
- 2. Add "and other aquatic organisms" to the first sentence under Environmental Hazards.
- 3. Revise the statement "Do not contaminate water, food or feed" to read: "Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage and disposal". Place the revised statement directly under the heading "Storage and Disposal".
- 4. Since this product is placed in Toxicity Category IV for the oral and inhalation routes of exposure, First Aid statements for these routes are not required. You may delete the *If* swallowed and *If Inhaled* statements.
