STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

If in eyes, flush with plenty of water and get medical attention. If on skin, wash with plenty of soap & water & get medical attention. If inhaled, remove victim to fresh air. If not breathing, give artificial respiration, preferably mouth to mouth. Get medical attention. If swallowed, promptly drink a large quantity of milk, egg whites, gelatin solution, or if these are not available, drink large quantities of water. Avoid alcohol. Get medical attention. Note to physician: Probable mucosal damage may contraindicate the use of gastric lavage.
