Hot Pepper Wax is liquid concentrate combined with water to effect a foliar spray to the leaves, stems, fruits, and flowers of the plant until wet. Do not drench roots in soil or media. Hot Pepper Wax effectively repels aphids, spider mites, thrips, leaf miners, white flies, lace bugs, leaf hoppers and scale. Hot Pepper Wax can be used on the following fruits and vegetables: citrus fruits, root and tuber vegetables, bulb vegetables, leafy vegetables, brassica (cole) leafy vegetables, legume vegetables, fruiting vegetables and curcubit vegetables. Apply Hot Pepper Wax using spray equipment. Do not apply Hot Pepper Wax through any type of irrigation system.

APPLICATION RATE & TIMING (Area less than 1 acre):
INITIAL rate is 1 part Hot Pepper Wax to 52 parts WATER. Apply until foliage is wet or a maximum of 3 gallons prepared solution per 1000 square feet. Repeat application in 3-7 days, for 2-3 weeks, until control is established. **ONCE CONTROL IS ESTABLISHED** use MAINTENANCE rate of 1 part Hot Pepper Wax to 64 parts WATER every 2-4 weeks, as necessary to maintain control.

APPLICATION RATE & TIMING (Acreage): INITIAL rate is a maximum of 3 gallons Hot Pepper Wax to a minimum 100 gallons WATER per acre. Apply until foliage is wet. Do not apply when rain is expected within 24 hours. Repeat application, if necessary, in 1 to 2 weeks, until control is established. **ONCE CONTROL IS ESTABLISHED** use MAINTENANCE rate of 1 gallon Hot Pepper Wax to a minimum 100 gallons WATER per acre, every 2-4 weeks, as necessary to maintain control.
