

Apply Hot Pepper Wax Ready to Use using spray equipment (do not apply through irrigation systems or soak soils).

APPLICATION AND TIMING: *SHAKE WELL*; Apply until foliage is wet. Repeat application in 3-7 days, 2-3 weeks, until control is established. **ONCE CONTROL IS ESTABLISHED**, use every 2-4 weeks, as necessary to maintain control.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL: Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal. Store securely under lock and key in a cool dry place.

DISPOSAL: Do not reuse empty containers. Rinse original container thoroughly and securely wrap in several layers of newspaper and discard in trash.
