The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with
registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and
Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable subject to the following
comments.

1. Add the statement " Wash thoroughly with soap and water
after handling." to the Hazards to Humans and Domestic
Animals section of the label.
2. Replace the heading "FIRST AID STATEMENT" with "STATEMENT
OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT".
3. Replace the statement "This product may be applied alone
or tank-mixed in combination with pesticides." to read
"This product may be applied alone or tank-mixed in
combination with pesticides in accordance with the more
restrictive of label limitations and precautions. No
label dosage rates may be exceeded. This product cannot
be mixed with any product containing a label prohibition
against such mixing."
4. Delete the statement "THIS PRODUCT DOES NOT REQUIRE A
RESTRICTED-ENTRY INTERVAL".

6. Modify "May be mixed with approved spreader/stickers and/or vegetable oils." to read "May be mixed with vegetable oils and/or spreader stickers approved for use on growing crops."

A stamped copy of the label is enclosed for your records. Submit five (5) copies of final printed labeling.

Please see the enclosed precautionary labeling review dated 3/30/93 for the subject product. Note that the dermal sensitization study is no longer required for this product. However, you are required under section 6(a)(2) of FIFRA to report all incidents of hypersensitivity to your product to the Agency.
