**PRODUCT DESCRIPTION:** Aqua Chem® Balanced For Clean Pools Black-Out is a potent way to destroy all types of algae growth on plaster pool surfaces. It is especially effective against black algae because it can be applied directly to the black spots which normally occur with this type of growth.

**IMPORTANT NOTES:**

1. Use this product **ONLY** on white plaster pool surfaces. It can bleach or damage painted surfaces or vinyl or fiberglass materials. When in doubt, check with your pool builder or manufacturer.
2. When applying this product on surfaces near water inlets and outlets, shut off pump before application and wait until granules have dissolved completely.
3. Never allow swimmers in pool until all granules have dissolved and water has been tested for a residual chlorine level no higher than 3.0 parts per million (ppm)

**DIRECTIONS FOR USE:**

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in any manner inconsistent with its labeling

**BEFORE YOU BEGIN**

1. Make sure all pool equipment is working properly, including pump, filter, skimmer and heater. Backwash filter following manufacturer's directions.
2. Check residual chlorine level with an Aqua Chem Test Kit. Desirable range is 1.0-1.5 parts per million (ppm). If necessary, add Aqua Chem Stabilized Granules or Aqua Chem Liquid Chlorinizer according to label directions until the chlorine residual reaches desired level.
3. Also check water pH (acidity/alkalinity balance) with an Aqua Chem Test Kit. Water pH should be 7.2-7.6. If not, adjust by adding Aqua Chem pH Decreaser to lower pH or Aqua Chem pH Add to raise pH. Be sure to follow product directions.

**NOW USE AQUA CHEM BLACK-OUT**

1. On horizontal surfaces, add Aqua Chem Black-Out directly to algae spots, covering them completely. For application on vertical or sloping pool surfaces, tie Aqua Chem Black-Out granules in cloth bundle or old sock and suspend with string against affected area. Do not add Aqua Chem Black-Out to pool skimmer.
2. Wait approximately 24 hours or until Aqua Chem Black-Out granules have dissolved completely. Brush covered spots with medium-grit wet/dry emery paper or stiff brush.
3. For large surface areas heavily covered with algae spots, this product may be spread over surface at a rate of 1 pound per 10,000 gallons of pool capacity. (When using this application method, guard against excessive skin contact with product. See "Physical and Chemical Hazards" statement and "Danger" statement elsewhere on this label).
4. Always recheck water for correct chemical levels after using Aqua Chem Black-Out. Adjust levels as necessary and follow all product directions before allowing swimmers to use pool.

**STORAGE AND DISPOSAL:** Keep this product in tightly closed original container when not in use. Store in a locked, cool, dry, well-ventilated area away from heat or open flame. In case of decomposition, isolate container (if possible) and flood area with large amounts of water to dissolve all materials before discarding this con-

tainer. Do not reuse empty container, but place in trash collection. Do not contaminate food or feed by storage, disposal, or cleaning of equipment.

**PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS: HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS DANGER:** Highly corrosive. Causes skin and eye damage. May be fatal if swallowed. Do not get in eyes, on skin, or on clothing. 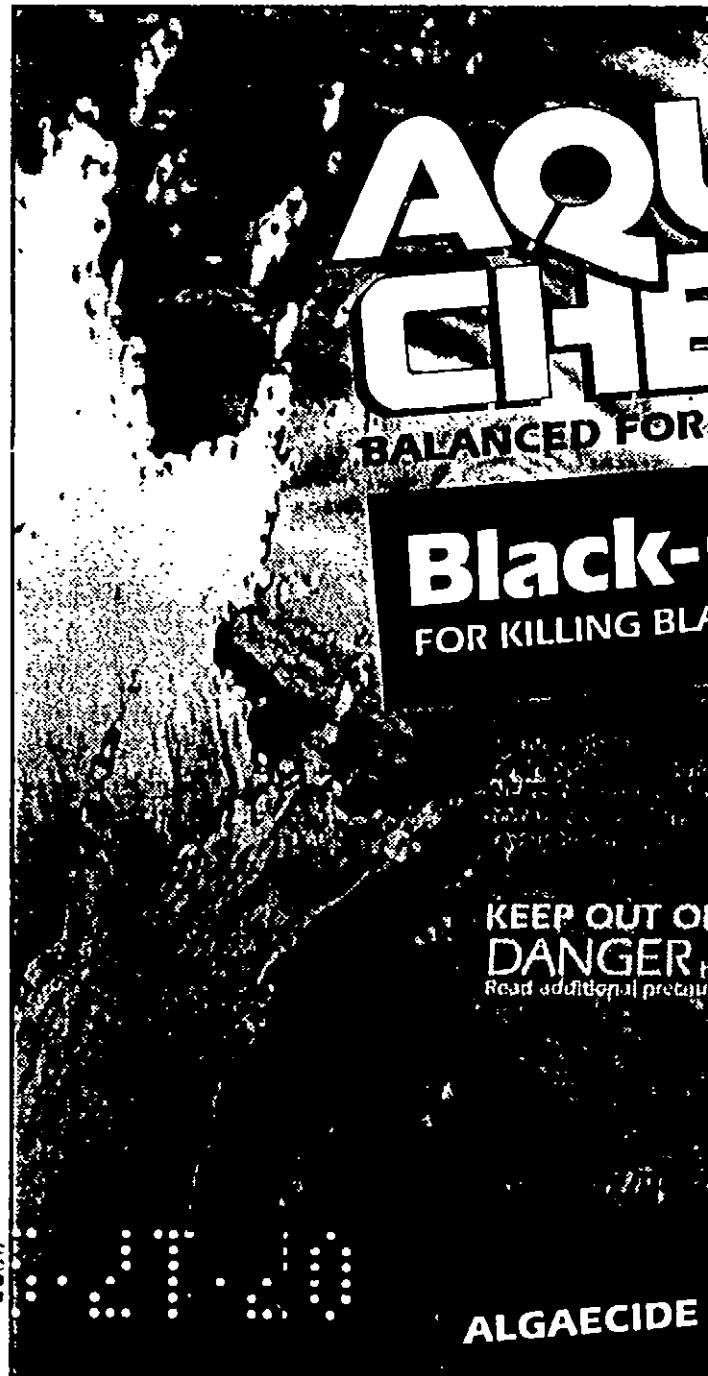
