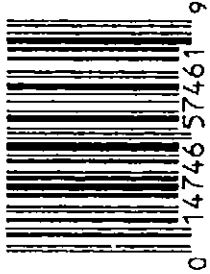

PRODUCT DESCRIPTION: Clean Spas Algaecide reduces the growth of algae and hot tubs. It is designed for routine maintenance program to prevent algae growths. This product is a water treatment chemical.

IMPORTANT NOTES:
1. Do not mix Aqua Chem concentrated dry or liquid. Explosion could result.
2. Sunlight, water temperature, frequency of spa use, unsanitary water, and local treatment application conditions.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE: It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in any manner inconsistent with the label directions. **BEFORE YOU BEGIN:**

1. Make sure all spa equipment including pump, filter, filter following manufacturer's instructions.
2. Check water pH (see Aqua Chem Test Kit). Adjust pH range is 7.4-7.6. Add Aqua Chem pH Adjuster following label directions.
3. Recheck pH and maintain at least 6 hours before use for Spas.

NOW USE AQUA CHEM ALGAECIDE:

1. To remove existing algae, add Algaecide at a rate of 1,000 gallons of water.
2. Operate recirculating pump for 1 hour afterward for maximum effect.
3. For newly cleaned spas, add Algaecide at a rate of 1,000 gallons of water by pouring into the filter pump while operating afterward.
4. To reduce future algae growth, add Algaecide as a regular maintenance program. Algaecide is recommended at 2.5 fl. oz. every 5-7 days following on usage conditions.
