**PRODUCT DESCRIPTION:** Aqua Chem® Balanced For Clean Spas Shock Treatment is a fast-dissolving, granular product used for periodic superchlorinating to eliminate most of the algae and micro-organisms found in a spa or hot tub. It helps prevent unsanitary water conditions and damage to spa surfaces and equipment which result from algae growth. This product will raise residual chlorine levels but is not intended for use as a routine chlorinator.

**IMPORTANT NOTES:** 1. When using other Aqua Chem products, as outlined in directions for Aqua Chem Shock Treatment, always follow label directions for those products. 2. These directions are for shock treatment under normal conditions. Sunlight, water temperature, the number of bathers, and the frequency and duration of spa use all affect the rate at which unsanitary water conditions develop. Adjust the frequency of applications accordingly. 3. Aqua Chem Shock Treatment should not be used more than once a day. If spa receives daily use, drain and refill with water every 30 days. 4. Wear rubber gloves and face shield or goggles when handling this product. Avoid breathing dust from product. Remove and clean contaminated clothing before reuse.

**DIRECTIONS FOR USE:** It is a violation of federal law to use this product in any manner inconsistent with its labeling. 1. Make sure all spa equipment is working properly, including pump, filter, skimmer and heater. Backwash filter following manufacturer's directions. 2. Check water pH (acidity/alkalinity) balance using a Test Kit following label directions. Desirable pH range is 7.4-7.6. If necessary, adjust pH by adding pH Decreaser to lower pH, or by adding pH Add to raise pH. Be sure to follow label directions. 3. Check residual chlorine level with an Aqua Chem Test Kit. For maximum effectiveness, chlorine level should be at least 1.0 parts per million (ppm) before Shock Treatment is added to water. If necessary, add Stabilized Granules for Spas following label directions until residual chlorine registers 1.0-2.0 ppm as measured by a test kit.

**NOW USE AQUA CHEM SHOCK TREATMENT:** 1. Make sure recirculating pump and aerator are not operating. Then add Shock Treatment granules at a rate of 1 ounce (2 Tbsp.) per 250 gallons of water by pouring granules into water. 2. Wait 10-15 minutes for granules to dissolve and disperse in water. 3. Operate recirculating pump for at least 1 hour to ensure even distribution of chemical in water. 4. Do not allow bathers to use spa until residual chlorine level is below 3.0 ppm measured by a test kit. 5. Use this product every 2 weeks as part of your routine maintenance program, or more frequently following heavy spa use.

**STORAGE AND DISPOSAL:** Keep this product in tightly closed original container when not in use. Store in a locked, cool, dry, well-ventilated area away from heat or open flame. In case of decomposition, isolate container (if possible) and flood area with large amounts of water to dissolve all ma-

terials before discarding this container. Do not reuse empty container but place in trash collection. Do not contaminate food or feed by storage or disposal, or cleaning of equipment.

**PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS: HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS. DANGER:** Highly corrosive. Causes skin and eye damage. May be fatal if swallowed. Do not get in eyes, on skin or on clothing. Wear goggles or face shield and rubber gloves when handling. Irritating to nose and throat. Avoid breathing dust. Remove and wash contaminated clothing before reuse.

**PHYSICAL AND CHEMICAL HAZARDS/STRONG OXIDIZING AGENT:** Mix only with water. Use clean, dry utensils. Do not add this product to any dispensing device containing remnants of any other product. Such use may cause a violent reaction leading to fire or explosion. Contamination with moisture, organic matter or other chemicals may start a chemical reaction, with generation of heat, liberation of hazardous gases, and possible generation of fire and explosion. In case of contamination or decomposition, do not reuse container. If possible, isolate container in open air or well-ventilated area. Flood with large volumes of water if necessary.

**ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS:** This pesticide is toxic to fish and aquatic organisms. Do not discharge effluent containing this product into lakes, streams, ponds, estuaries, oceans or other waters unless in accordance with the requirements of a National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) permit and the permitting authority has been notified in writing prior to discharge. Do not discharge effluent containing this product to sewer systems without previously notifying the local sewage treatment plant authority. For guidance contact your State Water Board or Regional Office of the EPA.

**STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT (FIRST AID): IF SWALLOWED:** Drink large quantities of water. Do not induce vomiting. Call a physician immediately. **IF ON SKIN:** Brush off excess dry chemical, flush with cold water for at least 15 minutes. **IF IRRITATION PERSISTS, obtain medical attention.**

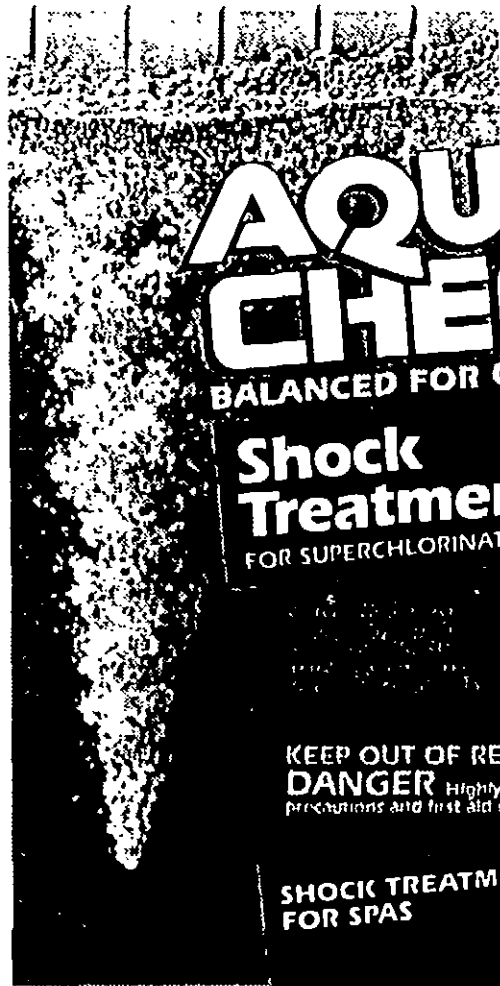
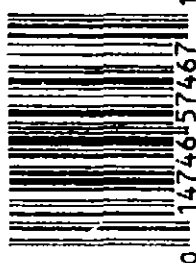
