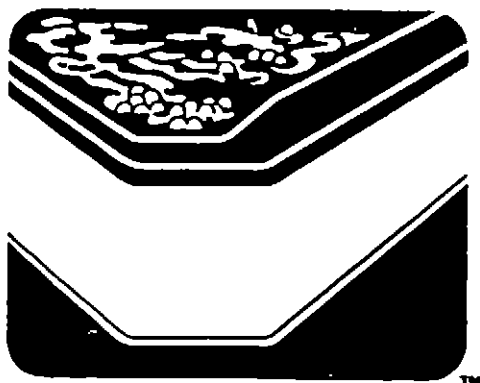

pools, and hot tubs containing heavy growth of algae should be
cleaned prior to using this product.

For spas, whirlpools, or hot tubs having just visible algae growth
add an initial dose of 2 to 4 fluid ounces of this product per 1,000
gallons of water.

For treatment of a freshly cleaned and filled spa, whirlpool, or hot
tub, add initially 1 to 2 fluid ounces of this product per 1,000 gallons
of water.

To maintain spas, whirlpools, or hot tubs free of visible algae
growth, subsequent additions of 0.5 to 0.8 fluid ounces of this
product should be made every 5 to 7 days after initial treatment for
maintenance.

This product is compatible with those chemicals normally used to
treat spas, and is effective at both acid and alkaline pH. This
product can be used in spas, treated with chlorine chemicals and

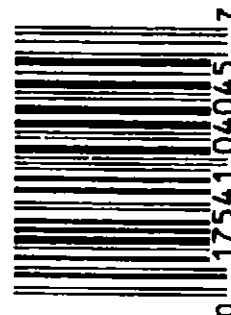

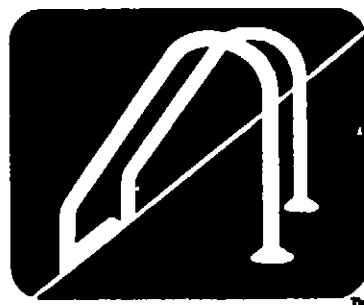

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. Pool Time Non-Foaming Algicide is used to control living algae in exterior spas, whirlpools, and hot tubs. For maximum effectiveness, exterior spas, whirlpools, and hot tubs containing heavy growth of algae should be treated with 12.8 fluid ounces per 10,000 gallons of water and re-treated as needed. For pools having just visible algae growth, add an initial dose of 12.8 fluid ounces per 10,000 gallons of water. Subsequent additions of 2.3 to 8.2 fluid ounces should be made every 5 to 7 days after initial treatment for maintenance. Spas, whirlpools, or hot tubs having just visible algae should be treated with 4 ounces per 1000 gallons of water. For treatment of whirlpools, or hot tubs, add initially 1 to 2 fluid ounces per 1000 gallons of water. Subsequent additions of 0.5 to 0.8 fluid ounces should be made every 5 to 7 days for maintenance.

Non-Foaming Algicide is compatible with those chemicals used in spas and is effective at both acid and alkaline pH. This product is not compatible with chlorine chemicals and may reduce the effectiveness of chlorine. However, do not mix this product with other chemicals.
