Upon completion of these reviews your Signal Word and Precautionary Statement may need to be changed. If so, you must submit, within 30 days of notification of these changes, revised labeling needed as a result of our reviews.

2. Submit, within eighteen (18) months after the date of registration of the subject product, a study(ies) of the Efficacy of Browsing Animal Repellents (Guideline Requirement No. 96-19) for this product. Depending upon the outcome of the Efficacy review, certain Use Directions and/or claims may need to be changed.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with the label. **USE RESTRICTIONS:** This product may be used to repel white-tailed deer (Cervus americana) on yew, American abornitae, or Douglas fir plants. Do not apply it on plants grown for animal feed. Do not apply at temperatures below 40°F, when it is windy, or when rain is expected. **APPLICATION DIRECTIONS:** Shake container of DEER-OFF spray thoroughly before use. Spray stems and branches thoroughly from all angles, until run-off or leaves look shiny. Begin treatment at the beginning of each damage season. Repeat treatment after heavy rains, or when the effects of the previous treatment appear to be waning. A one quart container of DEER-OFF contains enough spray to treat 40-50 ornamental shrubs or an area of about 400-500 sq. ft. of treated plants. Surface conditions and sizes of an area that can be treated with a given quantity of spray. Before large-scale treatments, test product on a small area of each type of plant to be sure that DEER-OFF will not damage the plant.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal. **STORAGE:** Store in a cool, dry area inaccessible to children and pets. Protect container closed tightly to prevent evaporation. If spillage occurs, dilute with water. **PESTICIDE DISPOSAL:** Wastes resulting from use of this product may be disposed of in an approved waste disposal facility. **CONTAINER DISPOSAL:** Sprayers should be triple-rinsed, then offered for recycling or punctured and disposed of in a sanitary landfill, or incinerated, or, if allowed by state or local authority, burned. If burned, stay out of smoke.
