#### DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with this labeling.  
**USE RESTRICTIONS:** This product may be used to repel deer and other garden variety animals that feed on flowers, bulbs, shrubs, plants, seedlings, etc. Deer-off discourages deer from feeding on bulbs dipped in concentrate formulation for 5 minutes and allowed to dry. Do not apply directly on plants grown to produce human food or animal feed. Do not apply at temperatures below 40° F, when it is windy, or when vegetation is wet.

**APPLICATION DIRECTIONS:** Shake container of DEER-OFF spray thoroughly before use. Spray leaves, stems and branches thoroughly from all angles, until run-off or leaves look wet. Treat vulnerable plants at the beginning of each damage season. Repeat treatment as new growth emerges, and if the effects of the previous treatment appear to be waning.

A one pint container of DEER-OFF contains enough spray to treat up to 25 ornamental shrubs 4 ft. high or an area about 250 sq. ft. of treated plants. Surface conditions and size of plantings will affect the size of the area that can be treated with a given quantity of spray. Before large scale treatments, test product on a small area of each type of plant to be treated to make sure that DEER-OFF will not damage the plant.

#### STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal.

**STORAGE:** Store only in original container, in a cool, dry area inaccessible to children and pets. Protect from heat and freezing. Store between 40°-90°. Keep tightly closed to prevent evaporation. If spillage occurs, dilute with water and flush away.

**PESTICIDE DISPOSAL:** Wastes resulting from use of this product may be disposed of on site or at an approved waste disposal facility.

**CONTAINER DISPOSAL:** Sprayers should be triple rinsed before discarding. Do not reuse empty container. All containers should be triple rinsed then offered for recycling or reconditioning, or punctured and disposed of in a sanitary landfill, or incinerated, or, if allowed by state and local authorities, burned. If burned, stay out of smoke.
