### Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals

### DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with the label.

### COMPOSITION AND APPLICABILITY

Intercide ABF-5 DIDP is a formulation of phenoxarsine specifically designed for use with flexible vinyl systems. It contains phthalate as its carrier.

The incorporation of approximately 10% Intercide ABF-5 DIDP based on the vinyl system will usually provide protection against the surface growth of many mildew fungi. It is recommended that each formulation be tested in a qualified laboratory in order to determine the level required for protection. Akcros can provide anti-fungal testing and/or formulations to meet individual requirements. It is necessary to incorporate levels as high as 10% in a vinyl system which is subjected to weathering.

Intercide ABF-5 DIDP contains 10% active ingredient in a formulation containing a primary plasticizer. It can be substituted directly for the equivalent plasticizer it is replacing.

### STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

#### PROHIBITIONS

Observe handling instructions given on label. Do not use for damage and skin burns. Do not use for food or feed by storage or disposal.

#### PESTICIDE DISPOSAL

Pesticide wastes are acutely hazardous. Improper disposal of excess pesticide, spray material, or empty containers is a violation of Federal law. Do not dispose of by use or pouring.
