The following amendment submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), as amended, is acceptable with the conditions listed below.

Revise the label as follows:

- 1.) Revise the 9th statement under the "Precautionary Statements" by adding the phrase, "...and before eating, drinking, chewing gum, smoking tobacco, or using the toilet."
- 2.) The statement after the "Precautionary Statements" must be brought into compliance with PR Notice 2000-5, Mandatory Labeling, by deleting the term, should, and stating "must."
- 3.) The 4th statement under "Composition and Application" must be brought into compliance with PR Notice 2000-5, Mandatory Labeling, by deleting the term, recommended.
- 4.) The "Container Disposal" statements must be revised to be in compliance with the Container Rule by stating:

Nonrefillable container. Do not reuse or refill this container. Triple rinse (or equivalent). Offer for recycling or reconditioning, if available. If not, puncture and dispose of in sanitary landfill or by other approved State and local procedures.

COMPOSITION AND APPLICATION

Intercide® ABF-5 DINP BA is a formulation of 10,10'-oxybisphenoxarsine specifically designed for compatibility with plastic products. It contains diisononyl phthalate as its carrier. The incorporation of approximately 0.6% by weight of Intercide® ABF-5 DINP BA based on the weight of the total plastic product will usually provide protection against the surface growth of many mildew organisms. It is recommended that each formulation be tested in a qualified laboratory in order to determine the optimum level required for protection. Akros Chemicals Inc. can provide anti-fungal testing and/or assistance in formulation to meet individual requirements. It may be necessary to incorporate levels high as 1.0% of this material in a plastic product which exposed to outside weathering. Intercide® ABF-5 DINP BA contains 10,10'-oxybisphenoxarsine in a formulation containing a primary plasticizer and can be substituted directly for the equivalent amount of plasticizer it is replacing.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal.

PESTICIDE STORAGE

Keep this product in a tightly closed container, when not in use. Store in a dry, well-ventilated area away from heat or open flame.

PESTICIDE DISPOSAL
