



COMPOSITION AND APPLICATION

Intericide® ABF-5 DIDP is a formulation of 10,10'-oxybisphenoxarsine specifically designed for compatibility with plastic products. It contains (Epoxidized Soybean Oil (ESO)) or (Epoxidized Soya Oil (ESO)) or (Benzoflex RF-501) or (Di-(2-Propylheptyl) Phthalate (Palatamol DPHPP)) or (Diisononyl Phthalate (DINP)) or (diisodecyl phthalate (DIDP)) or (Di-2-ethylhexyl phthalate (DEHP)) or (dialkyl (C7-11-branched & linear) phthalate (711)) or (diisodecyl phthalate (DIDP)) or (butyl benzyl phthalate(BBP)) or (polypropylene glycol (PPG)) or (DOTP)) as its carrier. The incorporation of approximately 0.6% by weight of Intericide® ABF-5 DIDP based on the weight of the total plastic product will usually provide protection against the surface growth of many mildew organisms.
