COMPOSITION AND APPLICATION

Intercide ABF-5 SV is a formulation of 10,10'exybisphenoxarsine specifically designed for compatibility with flexible vinyl systems. It is supplied as a solid, in a polymeric carrier.

The incorporation of approximately 0.6% by weight of Intercide ABF-5 SV based on the weight of the total vinyl system will usually provide protection against the surface growth of many mildew organisms, it is recommended that each formulation be tested in a qualified laboratory in order to determine the optimum level required for protection. Akcros Chemicals America can provide antifungal testing and/or assistance in formulation to meet individual requirements. It may be necessary to incorporate levels as high as 1.0% of this material in a vinvi system which is exposed to autside weathering.
