Personal Protective Equipment (PPE)

Applicators and other handlers must wear:
Coveralls over long sleeved shirt and long pants
Socks and chemical resistant footwear
Goggles or face shield
Chemical resistant gloves (such as waterproof or rubber gloves)

4. Revise the First Aid statements to read:

"FIRST AID

IF IN EYES: Hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15-20 minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing eyes. Call a Poison Control Center or doctor for treatment advice.

IF ON SKIN AND CLOTHING: Take off contaminated clothing. Rinse skin immediately plenty of water for 15-20 minutes. Call a Poison Control Center or doctor for treatment advice.

COMPOSITION AND APPLICATION

Intericide ABF-5 SVC is a formulation of 10,10'-oxybisphenoxarsine specifically designed for compatibility with flexible vinyl systems. It is supplied as a solid, in a polymeric carrier, in pelletized form.

The incorporation of approximately 0.6% by weight of Intericide ABF-5 SVC based on the weight of the total vinyl system will usually provide protection against the surface growth of many mildew organisms. It is recommended that each formulation be tested in a qualified laboratory in order to determine the optimum level required for protection. Akros Chemicals America can provide anti-fungal testing and/or assistance in formulation to meet individual requirements. It may be necessary to incorporate levels as high as 1.0% of this material in a vinyl system which is exposed to outside weathering.
