"To reduce the frequency of tearing of garbage bags by dogs and raccoons, spray entire bag thoroughly, including the bottom.

- c. Under the directions for use for Landscape Areas remove raccoons as one of the pests controlled. The product you cited does not have raccoons listed on its label.
- d. Under the direction for use for Landscape Areas change the sentence that reads, "Use spray setting" so that it reads, "Use stream setting".
- e. Under the directions for use for Lawns remove the statement that reads: "as well as the entire area to be protected".

Note the product you have cited to satisfy the data requirements for registration is currently undergoing reregistration. The labeling for this product is subject to further comments once that reregistration process is completed.

3. Submit one copy of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment. Refer to the A-79 enclosure for a further description of final printed labeling.

[BACK LABEL - OUTDOOR REPELLENT]

This unique product uses extracts of chili and essential oil of mustard to create an effective, dual-action animal repellent. It repels animals with an acute sense of smell and/or taste. The lemon scent is pleasant for humans. This product is guaranteed to work or your money will be refunded. Effective against dogs, cats, raccoons, squirrels, deer and rabbits.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Use Restrictions

For outdoor use only. Will stain fabric. Do not use where vegetable oil would be undesirable, such as car finishes, home sidings or screens. May stain concrete. Spray inconspicuous area to test. Animals will be repelled at the point of contact. It is important to cover entire area to be protected in each application.

**Garbage Bags:** To reduce the frequency of tearing of garbage thoroughly, including the bottom. Use spray setting. Effective upto 36 hours before garbage pickup.

**Nonbearing Trees and Shrubs:** To prevent deer from eating nonbearing shrubbery and trees, spray accessible areas of shrubs and trees. Use spray setting. Apply 0.07 oz. (approximately 2 full trigger sprays) per square foot. Repeat as needed.

**Landscape Areas:** To discourage digging by cats, dogs, raccoons and squirrels in landscaped areas, best results are achieved when product is applied to existing bark mulch. Wet entire area to be protected, especially outer perimeter. Use spray setting. Apply 0.20 oz. (approx. 5 full trigger sprays) per square foot. Reapply every 7 to 10 days.

**Lawns:** To discourage unwanted dogs, cats, raccoons and deer from entering lawn or garden, spray a five foot perimeter for border protection as well as the entire area to be protected. Use spray setting. Apply at 0.10 oz. (approximately 3 full trigger sprays) per square foot. Reapply every 7 to 10 days.

**Bird Feeders:** To discourage the raiding of bird feeders by squirrels, wet area around bird feeder including pole, tree limbs, trunk and leaves. Use spray setting for feeder and stream setting for all other areas. Apply at 0.10 oz. (approximately 3 full trigger sprays) per square foot. Reapply every 7 to 10 days.
