

- 1. Submit and/or cite all data required for registration/reregistration of your product when the Agency requires all registrants of similar products to submit data.
- 2. Make the labeling changes listed below before you release the product for shipment
 - a. Revise the EPA Registration Number to read, "EPA Reg. No. 67419-4"
 - b. The product chemistry review (copy is attached) noted that the ingredient statement on the label must match exactly the nominal concentration listed on the Confidential Statement of Formula (CSF). You must revise the Ingredient Statement to match the CSF, by listing the a.i. at 10.0%.
- 4. Within sixteen (16) months of the date on this Notice of Registration, provide to the Agency acceptable data packages for Guideline Studies as follows:
 - a. OPPTS 830.1600, (Description of Materials Used to make this product) OPPTS 830.1650 (Description of Formulation Process), 830.1670 (Discussion of Formation of Impurities), and 830.1750 (certified limits), plus a validated enforcement analytical method.
 - b. OPPTS 830.6214 (Data for Oxidation/Reduction), OPPTS 830.6317, (Storage Stability) and OPPTS 830.6320 (Corrosion Characteristics). If acceptable data is not submitted within 16 months of this NOR, this registration will expire on May 7, 2011.
 - c. OPPTS 810.3500 (Product Performance/Efficacy)—a guideline study must be submitted demonstrating adequate efficacy of the product against adult cat fleas to support the flea efficacy claims on the label. A copy of the Agency's efficacy review is attached.
- 5. Submit two (2) copies of the finished labeling bearing the above stated revisions prior to releasing the product for shipment.

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA sec. 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product constitutes acceptance of these conditions.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

May be applied to most water washable carpets, upholstered furniture, bedding, mattresses, and curtains. Do not use on "dry-clean only" rugs or fabrics. Test in an inconspicuous area to evaluate color fastness prior to overall application. Avoid use on waxed or polished wood, as water marks may develop. The Ecology Works DUSTMITE & FLEA CONTROL is designed to kill dust mites & fleas in the environment. Do not treat pets directly with this product.



Pre-cleaning Instructions:

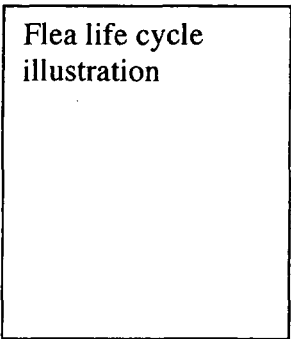
First clean by vacuum, laundering, or steam cleaning before applying DustMite & Flea Control. When treating couches and chairs, remove cushions, and vacuum all seams, and crevices. Clean both top and undersides of mattresses and box springs.

For control of dust mites & fleas in carpet:

Spray evenly to dampen and penetrate surface of carpet or rug. Do not saturate. A stiff brush or carpet rake will aid penetration on dense carpet pile. Avoid contact with treated surfaces until dry.

When treating drapes, upholstered furniture, mattresses & box springs, pet bedding:

Spray evenly to dampen and penetrate surfaces. Do not saturate. Spray all surfaces including undersides of cushions and wells of furniture. Allow to air dry before replacing cushions, mattresses & box springs. Spray all pet sleeping areas, including pet bedding. Avoid contact with treated surfaces until dry. Use of a fan may circulate air for quicker drying times.

When applied according to label directions the solution in this 32oz spray bottle will treat 100 sq ft (10 ft x10 ft).

TREATMENT INTERVAL

DustMite & Flea Control is effective reducing dust mite and flea population densities 4-6 weeks after initial treatment. Do not apply more than once every 8 weeks. Treatment lasts up to six months.

STORAGE & DISPOSAL
