The amount to be applied will vary depending on the severity of the problem and the site treated, but should be in the range of 1 to 2 ounces per 100 square feet of surface area. Applications should include, but are not limited to, cracks/crevices and void areas around and behind walls, cabinets, baseboards, moldings, pipe openings, electrical outlets, window and door frames and appliances. Repeat as necessary.

For Broadcast Treatments (Attics, Crawl Spaces, False Ceilings, etc.): Apply uniformly around the perimeter and in and around areas where insects may be hiding or living. Apply at a rate of 12 to 16 ounces per 1000 square feet of surface area, depending on the severity of the problem. Repeat as necessary.

For Treatments in Commercial Food Handling Establishments: Applications of this product in the food areas of food handling establishments is limited to void or crack and crevice treatment. The amount to be applied will vary depending on the severity of the problem and the site treated, but should be in the range of 1 to 2 ounces per 100 square feet of surface area. Use equipment capable of applying dust directly into voids, cracks and crevices between different elements of construction, between equipment and floors, openings leading to voids and hollow spaces in walls, equipment legs and bases where insects hide. Repeat as necessary.


