

**DIRECTIONS FOR USE:**

IT IS A VIOLATION OF FEDERAL LAW TO USE THIS PRODUCT IN A MANNER INCONSISTENT WITH ITS LABELING. EcoPCO™ EC is intended to be applied with a pressurized sprayer or other equipment suitable for applying insecticides to localized areas. Dilute EcoPCO™ EC with water at a rate of 10 parts of water per 1 part of concentrate. Shake or agitate to mix well.

**For Crack/Crevise and Void Treatments:** Use a low pressure system with a pinpoint nozzle or injector tip and apply into cracks/crevices and void spaces where insects may be crawling, hiding or living. Apply adequately to thoroughly cover the areas being treated. Applications can be made, but are not limited to, behind baseboards, cabinets, floors, walls, ceilings, door and window frames, and around water pipes and appliances. Particular attention should be given to treating entry points and harborage areas. Repeat as necessary.

**For General Surface Treatments (fleas and ticks):** Use a low pressure system with a fan type nozzle to uniformly apply the dilution. Applications can be made, but are not limited to, areas such as infested rugs, floor coverings and upholstered furniture and pet bedding. Apply between and under cushions of furniture and under edges of floor coverings where possible. Apply approximately 1 gallon of diluted product per 1500 sq. ft. Old bedding should be removed and replaced after treatment. Repeat as necessary.

**For Spot Treatments:** Use a low pressure system with a fan type nozzle to uniformly apply the dilution. Applications should be made where pest activity has been detected and around areas where pests may enter the structure. Apply adequately to thoroughly cover the areas being treated. Repeat as necessary.

**For Treatments in Commercial Food Handling Establishments:** Applications are permitted in both food/feed and non-food areas of food/feed handling establishments as a general surface, spot, or crack / crevice treatment. Do not apply as a general surface application in food handling areas when the facility is in operation or foods are exposed. Spot or crack/crevice applications may be made while the facility is in operation; however, food should be covered or removed from area being treated.
