

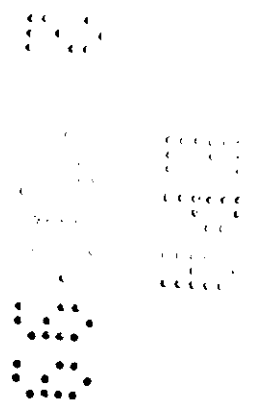

Shake well before using.

For Crack/Crevise and Void Treatments: use the injector nozzle tip provided, and inject into all crack/crevice and void spaces where insects may be crawling, hiding, or living. Release approximately 1 to 2 seconds per cubic foot treated. Apply more liberally for heavy infestations. Several holes may be required in long-running voids. Applications can be made, but are not limited to, behind baseboards, cabinets, floors, walls, ceilings, door and window frames, and around water pipes and appliances. Ensure contact with as many insects as possible. Repeat as necessary.

For General Surface Treatment: Fleas- hold can approximately 3 feet above surface area and apply lightly and uniformly at a rate of 10 seconds per 100 square feet to infested areas such as carpets, rugs, cloth upholstery and pet bedding. Repeat as necessary.

For Wood Injection: Drywood Termites- spot treatment for localized infestation. Probe to locate galleries, drill holes and inject 5 to 10 seconds per hole into active galleries. **Powder Post Beetles-** treat infested wood using injection tube. Apply small amounts directly into and around entrance holes. **Carpenter Bees-** seal entrance openings with stainless steel wool after application.

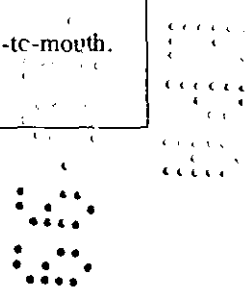
