### Shake well before using.

This product is a contact spray and will not prevent reinfestation of any listed pest in any treated area. Insects must be contacted by spray in order to ensure 100% mortality.

The following table provides the minimum and maximum time to obtain 100% contact mortality for tested insects in the laboratory. Flushing action and knockdown time were not measured in this testing.

Contact fleas & ticks directly to kill these pests.
