

A copy of the Acute Toxicity review of the cocktail formulation is enclosed for your records.



FIRST AID

If Swallowed - Call a Poison Control Center or Doctor immediately for treatment advice. Have a person sip a glass of water if able to swallow. Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by the Poison Control Center or Doctor. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

EcoPCO® G/X is intended primarily for outdoor applications using a hand-operated spreader or equivalent equipment such as shaker cans. Also for use on plants intended for aesthetic purposes or climate modifications and being grown in interior plantscapes, ornamental gardens or parks, or lawn or grounds.

For Exterior Perimeter Treatments: Apply uniformly to ground area 6 to 10 feet wide around and adjacent to structure. Apply 3 to 6 lbs. per 1000 sq. ft. (rates depend on severity of infestation).

For Boundary Treatments: Apply to soil areas, ornamental gardens, pavement crevices, fencelines, planter areas, vegetation areas and mulch areas.

For Ant Mounds/Nests: Sprinkle 1 to 2 teaspoons over the nest. For red imported fire ant mounds, use up to ½ cup (8 tablespoons) over each mound and up to 2 feet around each mound.

For Broadcast Spot Treatments: For control of actively foraging ants, broadcast uniformly 3 to 6 pounds (rates vary based on severity of infestation).

Food utensils such as tablespoons must not be used for food purposes after use in measuring

pesticides.
