DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

USE RESTRICTIONS: Children and pets should not be in treated areas until application is completed. Avoid contamination of ornamental plants.

APPLICATION DIRECTIONS

CARPETS: Apply to dry carpet only. Apply directly to carpet. Do not vacuum or traffic or sleep at the rate of one pound per 100 square feet. For areas apply at the rate of one pound per 200 square feet. Use a vacuum to the base of the carpet pile with a broom or rug brush. Do not use on equipment. Visible product remaining after application must be removed by vacuuming.

Allow three to five weeks for maximum flea control. Repeat application as needed.

Note: If high adult flea population makes it desirable to kill adult fleas before or in conjunction with this product, use a flea comb.

UPHOLSTERY: Remove loose cushions. Apply to creases and into corners and furniture wells. Do not apply to leather. Any product visible after application must be removed by vacuuming.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

STORAGE: Keep container tightly closed when not in use. Store in a cool, dry place, inaccessible to children and animals.

PESTICIDE DISPOSAL: Wastes resulting from the use of this product should be disposed of on site or at a waste disposal facility.

CONTAINER DISPOSAL: Do NOT reuse container. Then offer for recycling or reconditioning, or puncture and dispose in a sanitary landfill, or incinerator, or, if allowed by State and local authorities, burned, stay out of smoke.
