This product is conditionally registered in accordance with FIFRA sec. 3(c)(7)(A) provided that you:

1. Submit and/or cite all data required for registration/reregistration of your product under FIFRA sec. 3(c)(5) when the Agency requires all registrants of similar products to submit such data; and submit acceptable responses required for reregistration of your product under FIFRA section 4.

2. Make the following label changes:

- a. Revise the EPA Registration Number to read, "EPA Reg. No. 67496-1".
- b. In accordance with 40 CFR 156.10(a)(5), remove the statement "Does not contain petroleum distillates". This statement is considered to be a safety claim.
- c. Revise the phrase "Hazardous to humans and domestic animals" to read: "Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals". This revised subheading should be placed below the general heading of Precautionary Statements. The following information should be displayed in this paragraph: "Causes eye irritation. Do not get in eyes, on skin, or on clothing. Do not breathe vapors or spray mist. Wash contaminated skin areas thoroughly after handling. Avoid contamination of food and feedstuffs, utensils, and food preparation areas. Remove pets, birds, and cover fish aquariums before spraying."

e. The statement, "It is a violation of federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling", must appear immediately after the heading, "Directions for Use."

f. Remove the phrase, "For General Use", since the use of product is not classified.

g. Add the following paragraph to your label:

Environmental Hazards

Keep out of lakes, ponds or streams. Do not contaminate water by cleaning of equipment or disposal of wastes.
